As of Shopware 6.7.14 (September 2026). Type sequences one key after the other, at most one second apart.
Shortcuts are paused while an input field has focus.

GENERAL

Shift + ?	Open the list of all shortcuts (also lets you disable them)
F	Focus the search field
O F	Open the filter panel (lists with filters) 6.7.13+
Esc	Cancel detail view, close dialog or flyout
Alt + S	Save the current view Mac: Control + S , also works inside an input field
Alt + C	Clear cache (dialog) Mac: Control + C
Tab	Focus the next element
Shift + Tab	Focus the previous element
Tab Enter	Skip navigation, jump straight to the content

Good to know.

- Multi-key shortcuts are sequences, not chords: release **G**, then press **P**. Keys must be at most one second apart, otherwise the sequence starts over.
- Shortcuts only fire while no input field, text area, select or editor has focus. The exception is save with **Alt** **Control**: it blurs the field first, then saves.
- Permissions apply: without the product privilege **A** **P** does nothing, and "Clear cache" needs the system privilege.
- To disable shortcuts (for example because a browser extension uses the same keys), use the toggle at the bottom of the overview under **Shift** + **?**. The setting is stored per browser.
- Several tabs: right-click a menu entry, "Open in new tab". All tabs share the session, logging out in one logs out all of them.
